I operate a 14' refrigerated truck to deliver prepared food to schools and community programs that provide lunch to after school programs. I am required to complete logs recording my time and the temperature of the food when delivered. I am required to complete maintenance logs and hourly logs. I am responsible for loading/unloading of the load as well as proper securing of loads while in transport.

Driver, Apogee Trucking / Savers

Feb 2016 - Mar 2018

Class B certified CDL Driver. My position was created by the retail outlet Savers to utilize an empty store location as a warehouse to hold back stocked product in an attempt to free up space in the stores and reduce waste. My job duties include receiving back stock orders from the seven valley retailers. I then fill the order by loading pallets of back stock onto my truck with a propane powered fork lift. I deliver the product to the stores on a rotating weekly schedule. I then receive new back stocked product from the store and inventory it in the warehouse. I created the organizational layout of the warehouse and managed all operations with little to no supervision. Responsibilities also include, pre and post trip vehicle inspections, general vehicle maintenance, keeping accurate trip logs, keeping up to date knowledge of trucking rules and regulations, scheduling pickup and drop off of product, inventory logs and records, Communicating with store management to schedule deliveries, forklift operations, handheld forklift (Big Joe), and warehouse management and operation.

Bus Driver, Tempe Elementary District 3

Aug 2015 - Feb 2016

I was CDL certified bus driver for the Tempe Unified School District. My duties include safe transportation for student K-8. I am responsible for not only safe transportation while operating the bus but student management as well. I am responsible for all pre trip inspections and basic vehicle maintenance. Beyond filling out ongoing maintenance logs I complete work orders and communicate with the shop to make sure all work is completed in a timely manner before the bus is returned to service.

As a Pool Tech at X Pools I provided a route based service cleaning and servicing pools for our clients. I provided cleaning services as well as maintenance and some repairs. I was responsible for all the pools on my route. I cleaned and took chemical readings on a weekly basis. I chemically treated pools as needed. I completed daily logs on each pool documenting what treatments were done, what needed to be completed, and if there were any issues that needed to be addressed I would generate a work order for the parts so I could complete the work or a mechanic could be dispatched to do the repair.
